



The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents, that we Vincent Wilson and William Wilson of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and ninety two dollars to us paid by Elisha Green of Greenville District and State of our said State have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elisha Green, a certain tract or parcel of land adjoining the said Elisha Green's land & Archibald Fowler & others, Resurveyed by Benjamin Griffith Esq. on the 29 day of August 1817. as a reference to the annexed plat will more fully shew. Containing two hundred and thirty acres more or less whereon the said William Wilson, now lives situate in the district and State aforesaid which was conveyed from Thomas G. Walker, to the said Vincent & William Wilsons and now from the said Wilsons to the said Elisha Green. Do have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Elisha Green his heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind our selves and our joint and several heirs Executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Elisha Green his heirs and assigns against our selves and our heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Witness our hands and seals this the fourth day of April A.D. one thousand eight hundred and twenty three in the presence of Vincent Wilson  Richard Goodlett, William Wilson  South Carolina. Do wit Personally appeared before me the Greenville District & Subscriber, Richard Goodlett, and made oath that he saw Vincent Wilson and William Wilson sign seal and acknowledge the within deed of conveyance to Elisha Green for the use and purpose therein mentioned and that J. H. Goodlett was a subscribing witness with him self to the same with him self sworn to be fore me this 5 May 1823. J. H. Goodlett c.c.p. & S.D. Richard Goodlett.
