Know all men by these presents that I Aaron Kemp have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto Edward Allen one hundred acres of land for and in consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by the said Edward Allen the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same I have and to hold the said plantation or tract of land it being part of a tract originally granted to George Lewis and by said conveyed to the said Kemp and now by the said Kemp to Edward Allen lying and being on brush creek on the upper end of said original tract beginning at a pine knot corner & runs N 52 W 27 chains to a red oak corner thence S 10 W 12 chains to a poplar corner thence S 62 W 27 chains to a black oak corner thence S 24 E 60 chain to a stake on Attons line thence a long Attons line to the upper end of said original tract thence to the beginning by the same more or less together with all the rights members and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise therunto belonging to him the said Edward Allen his heirs and assigns forever and of the said Aaron Kemp do hereby for ever warrant and defend the same from my self my heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16th day of April 1823.
