William Thomason this day became indebted to Charity Martin two hundred dollars which she this day binds her self to pay Joseph Sullivan and to for two Judgments amounting to one hundred and eight ten dollars 72 3/4 Cents together with interest and cost supposed to make the aforesaid sum of two hundred dollars Now know all men by these presents that I the said William Thomason in order to secure the payment of said judgments with the cost and interest thereon have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the said Charity Martin one stud horse, about five years old 14 1/2 hands high one bay filly four feather beds and furniture swan head of meat cattle six head of sheep eight ten head of hogs one cup board chest and table, and three or one Dutch oven one paster dish, twelve plates & two basons. To have and to hold all and singular the above named property to her the said Charity Martin her heirs and assigns forever Provided never the less and it is expressly understood that if the above named William Thomason pays or causes to be paid unto the said Charity Martin the aforesaid sum of two hundred dollars on or before the 7th day of April then the above mortgage or bill of sale to be void and of none effect Other wise the said Charity Martin her heirs Exrs. &c. is hereby authorized to take immediate possession of said property and proceed to sell the same conformably to law for the purpose
