Crowder Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid ~~and by~~ virtue of the Statute in such cases made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of one hundred and forty seven dollars to me in hand paid, ~~by~~ or secured to be paid by the said William Bates, the receipt and payment I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said William Bates his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appertinances, and all the Estate, Right title and Interest which the said Moses Bates of Right had of in and to the same; To Have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appertinances unto the said William Bates his heirs, and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said Asa W. Crowder might, could or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of fieri facias or other wise In witness whereof, I the said Asa W. Crowder have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three Sealed Signed and delivered in the presence
