shall come. I Aza W. Browder Sheriff of Grimville Distric-
-ct and State aforesaid, and granting Writs, by virtue of
-on Sunday writs of fine facias, issued out of the Court of Comm-
-on Pleas held for the district of Grimville on the first
day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
Hundred and twenty two at the suit of David Dutton
against Joseph Evans and William S. Dill, and at the suit
of John Henson against Joseph Evans & John Gentry
to me directed, commanding me that of the good and chattels
land and tenements of the said defendants to levy the sum
of one hundred and twenty five dollars damages and costs
I have seized and taken of the land and tenements of the said
Joseph Evans all that certain piece parcel and tract of
Land containing two hundred and eighty five acres more or
less situate and being in the district of Grimville and State aforesaid
-said in two tracts, one of one hundred and eighty five acres
originally granted to Daniel Dutton, by grant dated the 5th
January 1789 and conveyed to the said Joseph Evans by the
-ron Earle, John Montgomery, and John Miller by deed dated
the 17th May 1816. Beginning at a Pole running S. 65. W. 35 to a hickory
thence S. 6. to a stake thence E. 3. E. 30. L. to a Pole thence N. 7. W. 23. 50
to a pine thence S. 7. E. 20. to a chestnut thence N. 20. E. 30 to a Pole
thence N. 75. E. 30. 50 to a Pole & chestnut thence S. 6. E. 44. 20 to a chest-
-nut thence S. 65. W. 7. to a black Jack thence N. 70. W. 15 to a sta-
-ke thence N. 71. W. 9. to the beginning the other of one hundred
acres originally granted to Nimrod Dill by grant dated
the 5th Jan'y 1801 and by him conveyed by deed dated the 1st Oct.
1805. to John Dill and by him conveyed to the said Joseph
