Clark all that Plantation or tract of land containing one hundred and twenty seven acres (more or less) Situate in the district of Greenville lying on the South fork of Horse Creek waters of Ruddy River — Beginning on a Stake 3x on said Creek running thence N 32 E 31.00. to a Post oak 3x thence S 29. Thomas J. Hare's land thence N 62 E 17 10. to a rock 3x thence S 28 E 53 to a red oak 3x bounding on E 39. to a small Hickory 3x bounding on Benjamin Arnold's thence up the meanders of said Creek to the beginning Together with all and singular the Rights members Accoutrements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singling as the premises before mentioned unto the said John T. Clark his heirs and assigns for ever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John T. Clark a gainst myself my heirs and a gainst every other person who anywhere lawfully claim in or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and Seal this 17th day of February eighteen hundred and twenty four and in the fortieth year of the American Independence Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of James Navel, Nathaniel Clark, William Wright Seal Greenville District Personally came Nathaniel Clark before me and made oath that he saw William Wright of the State of Georgia sign seal and deliver the within deed of conveyance for the use and purposes therein mentioned and that James Navel was a subscribing witness with him self at the same time Sworn to the 24th February 1824
