The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I William Hall of Greenville District in the state aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ten dollars to me paid by Walter Ashmore of Greenville District in the state aforesaid have granted ^{bargained} sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Walter Ashmore a certain piece or tract of land lying and being in Greenville District of the state aforesaid on Laffettys branch being part of a tract of Land originally granted to John Laffetty and signed by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the 6 day of Oct. 1788. the piece of land now intended to be conveyed containing forty acres be the same more or less and beginning on a sassafras 37 on Kellys line thence along said line to the bank thence up said bank to the Branch thence up S. branch to a Spanish oak 37. thence said line to a Hickory thence down Kellys Line to the beginning, also thirty acres more of land be the same more or less originally granted to Jeff Green the third day of August 1802 lying in the District aforesaid on a branch of ^{River} Reckers beginning on a maple 37. on the marrow bone branch of Kellys land thence running along said line to a Post oak 37. thence along said line to main marrow bone Branch to the fork of the other fork thence up S. fork to the beginning corner also one other tract or parcel of land containing sixty acres be the same more or less lying and being in the District of the state aforesaid beginning on a Spanish oak at the head of a small Branch thence down said Branch to a wash corner on Williams line along said Williams line to a branch to a stake corner thence down said Branch to the creek thence up said creek to the ^{old} original Line thence along said line to the beginning all the said lands ^{now} intended to be conveyed is recorded in Book I. in the Clerks office Greenville in pages 390 & 391 & 495. Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Walter Ashmore ^{his} heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs, Executors and admin
