This indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 1818  
 Between Richard Ward, of the District of Greenville and  
 State of southcarolina, of the one part and Abner Center  
 of the State and district aforesaid of the other, part wit  
 nesses that for and in consideration of the sum of forty  
 Pounds sterling to him in hand paid by the sd Abner Center  
 The receipt, whereof is hereby fully acknowledged, hath <sup>been</sup> ~~been~~  
 and sold and by their presence both bargain sell and deliver  
 unto the sd Abner Center his Heirs and assigns forever a certa  
 in tract or parcel of land situate lying and being on the  
 Head of fortenturys fork of tyger River, it being a part of  
 a tract of land surveyed for Hugh Thomson, Nov: 1: 1781  
 Having such marks as follows beginning w<sup>h</sup> oak running then  
 No. 55. w. 29 to a hickory thence No 16 to stake thence No 63 E  
 23 to a conditional whemut in or near the open line thence No.  
 27. w 15 and 56. links to a pine thence No. 3 w 4 and 50 to w. h  
 oak thence No 10 w to beginning supposed to contain fifty acres  
 Be same more or less it being a tract of land conveyed from  
 Abner Center to Richard Ward and now conveyed back by  
 Richard Ward to Abner Center together with all and sing  
 ular the rights and premises to same belonging or in any  
 appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the sd  
 premises to those and before of him the sd Abner Center his  
 Heir and assigns shall and will warrant and for ever defend
