




 Hugh Roark of the county of Greenville in the state aforesaid
 In consideration of the sum of ten dollars, to me paid by Isaac
 Cox of the county and state aforesaid have granted bargain
 And released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said Isaac Cox, twenty five acres of Land more or less be-
 ing part of a tract of Land originally granted to George Scarborough
 And signed by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the second day
 June one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight as by a plat
 Annexed to the S^d Grant will more fully appear the said twenty
 five acres of Land more or less lying on the north side of Rudy
 River's said out unto the said Isaac Cox, as follows, beginning at a
 State corner on the S^d Isaac Cox line and running on the S^d Cox line
 To a state corner on Thomas Long's line thence running a long the S^d
 Long's line to the widows ashmore line and thence a long the widows
 Ashmore line to a pine corner thence running a direct line to the
 Beginning state corner including twenty five acres of Land more
 or less together with all and singular the rights members heirs inheritances
 And appertinences to the said premises belonging in any wise in-
 -ent or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the prem-
 -ises before mentioned unto the said Isaac Cox his heirs and assigns
 Forever and I do here by bind my self my heirs Executors and admin-
 -istrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
 Twenty five acres of Land with the premises unto the said Isaac
 Cox his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and assigns in
 witness where of I do hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth
 Day of July one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Eight with
 my present Benjamin Pollard, Benjamin Arnold, Hugh Roark
