Benjamin Pollard son of the District of Greenville in the State
Aforesaid in consideration of five hundred & fifty dollars to me
Paid by Alexander Sloan in the State & District aforesaid, have granted
bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell
and release unto the said Alexander Sloan that part of the tract of
Land originally granted to John Pyle where J. A. Pollard now lives
containing two hundred acres of land be the same more or less lying
on the North East side of Pyles Branch & originally granted to John
Pyle & signed by his Excellency Benjamin Moultrie & the 5th May 1785
and layd out as follows. Beginning on a willow corner on the N side of
Pyles Branch at the water edge thence N 20. E 52. c to a sower wood corner,
thence S 60. E 40. to a light wood stake corner S 50. E 16. 50 to a stake at the
water edge of Pyles Branch thence up the said Branch with the water
edge to the beginning but not so as to abstract the said Benjamin
Pollard from rebuilding or repairing & continuing his mill Dam or
Dam together with the rights member, hereditaments & appurtenances
to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto
The said Alexander Sloan his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby
bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & for
ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Alex
ander Sloan his heirs & assigns against my self & my heirs & against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
