as by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out of the Court of Com-
mons Pleas, held for the district of Greenville tested the nineteenth day
of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
five at the suit of Francis B. Walker to me directed, commanding
me to take the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of Beverly Daniel
the sum of two hundred and sixty nine dollars & 23/100 damages and costs
and to seize and take of the lands and tenements of the said Beverly Daniel
at certain piece parcel and tract of Land, containing one hun-
dred & sixty acres more or less situate and being in the district of Green-
ville beginning on a red oak XIII on James Paynes land running East 14.75 chains to
a stake XIII. thence N. 70. E. 20 chains to a pine stump in Joshua Ingrims
thence N. 14. E. 16 chains to a red oak XIII. down in John Lockrums horse lot
N. 41. W. 68 chains on Col. Walkers land to a Black Jack (dead) XIII. & from
thence N. 2. E. 68 chains to the beginning and where are as the said premises, with their appur-
tenances since the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias
mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased by
Isaiah Cox of the district of Greenville & State aforesaid for the sum of one hundred
ninety two dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor: Now
know ye that I Nimrod Underwood Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the writ of
Fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the
Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of
said sum of one hundred and ninety two dollars to me in hand
paid or secured to be paid by the said Isaiah Cox the receipt of
