 19 to a post oak then N. 55. E 13 to the road then down the road to
 the beginning which includs the lands herein to be conveyed being
 eighty acres Together with all and singular the rights members and
 appertinances unto the said premises belonging or in any wise in-
 cident or appertaining To Have And To Hold the said premises unto
 the said David J. Burton his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind
 myself my heirs & to warrant & forever - the said premises unto the said
 David J. Burton against myself my heirs & against all and every person
 or person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
