This Indenture <sup>49</sup> made the sixteenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between Aron Hemp of Greenville District and State of South Carolina of the one part and Joseph Edwards of the aforesaid State and District of the other part witnesseth that the said Aron Hemp for an inconsideration of the sum of fifty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Edwards the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Aron Hemp hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Edwards a certain tract or parcel of land being and lying in Greenville District on the bank of Enoree River containing One hundred acres more or less it being part of a tract of land originally granted to Rich Cannon beginning on a stake joining William Hedges from thence West to a post oak corner thence so to a pine corner joining Joseph Edwards thence East to a red oak corner joining Ansel Runnels thence so to a conventional line to the beginning the said hundred acres more or less it being a part of a tract of land originally laid out for Rich Cannon to have and to hold and every part thereof to the said Joseph Edwards his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Aron Hemp doth for himself and his heirs assigns from all and every person and persons will warrant and for ever defend to the said Joseph Edwards in witness whereof the said Aron Hemp hath set his hand and seal the day and year above written
