W. 11.50 links to a maple corner thence S. 52. 10 S. chains to a red Oak corner thence S. 15 E 31. 25. Links to a post Oak corner thence N 21 E 15. 50 links to the beginning corner together with all and singular the rights and members Hereditaments and appertenance to the sd premises. belonging or in anywise incident. or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the sd. John Green his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the sd premises to the sd John Green his heirs. and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons. who or whosoever lawfully claim or to claim the same or any part thereof whereas witness my hand and Seal this the 24th of March one Thousand Eight Hundred and Seven by five Silvan Miller

Witnesseth that the said Thomas G. Walker for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand two Hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand well and truly paid. by the said William J. Rowland at or before the signing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Thomas G. Walker hath granted bargained sold conveyed, remise and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, convey, remise & confirm unto the said William J. Rowland and his heirs forever all those four Lots, pieces or parcels of Land situate lying and being in the Village of Greenville in the State of South Carolina known and distinguished in a plan of said Village by the numbers Twentee (17) Eighteen (18) Nineteen (19) and Twenty (20) upon which the said Thomas G. Walker formerly resided which said Lots were sold and conveyed by the said Thomas G. Walker to Oliver M. Lillibridge of Savannah Georgia and the said Oliver M. Lillibridge having failed to pay to the said Thomas G. Walker the consideration therefor he the said Oliver M. Lillibridge and Maria Lillibridge his wife on the
