ver such deed, Conveyance, bargain and sale, for the absolute sale and disposal the
se of or of any part thereof with such clause, covenant, and agreement to
be therein contained, as my said attorney shall think fit and expedient thereby
ratifying and confirming all such lease or leases, deed, Conveyance, bargains
or sales which shall at any time hereafter be sealed and executed by my

Greenville District to between Joseph P. Colborne of the one part
and Alexander Nickers of the other part witnesseth that the said Alexander
Nickers contracts and agrees to take charge of the mills of the said Colborne
on Rudy River near the village for the term of one year and to do all
