March 15th & 16th 1827. then received of William H. Salmon the amount of Six thousand three hundred and sixty four dollars and sixty Cents in the land wherein is returned to James Pickett and other property returned to me which sum is credited on his bond up to 13th July 1826. attest - Thos Blyth, Nan G.
