of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of two hundred and eighty
eight dollars to me paid by Dempsey Nisbett of Laurens District and State aforesaid have
Granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and
release unto the said Dempsey Nisbett all that plantation or tract of land containing
Ninety six Acres of land be the same more or less situate in the District of Greenville
lying on the branches of Rudy River beginning on a Rock &c thence S 2 E 35 50 on the
old Indian line to a pine &c thence N 76 W 33 00 to a pine &c bounding on Mtn. L.
Gunnell, thence N 2 W 26 50 to a Stake &c bounding on John Thompson's land
thence N 88 E 31 00 on said William Choice's land to the beginning together with all and singular
the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises, before men-
tioned unto the said Dempsey Nisbett his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my
self, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular
the said premises, unto the said Dempsey Nisbett his heirs and assigns against myself and
my heirs and against every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this fifteenth day of April in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five and in the
forty ninth year of the Independence of the United States of America ^{the} ~~the~~ signed sealed and
