


Paid by William Brain of the State of District aforesaid have granted sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto the said William Brain all that tract of land on the North side of Thompsons River dam Creek the same being part of a Tract of Land granted to James Joseph Maxwell; beginning on the South Fork of said Creek on the upper line thence to a sower wood at or near the North fork of said Creek thence to a Post-oak corner thence to an other Post-oak thence to the creek thence up said Creek to the beginning corner containing One hundred acres more or less Together with all & singular the Rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining To Have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said William Brain his heirs Executors & administrators & assigns for ever & I do warrant & for ever defend all that parcel of land aforesaid from the Claim of me the said Hezekiah Cokerum my heirs Executors administrators and assigns from the Claim of all & every person or persons lawfully Claiming the same or any part thereof -

The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I James Kilgore of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for divers good causes & Considerations well as for the promotion of divine worship at a new Meeting House known by the name of the Clear Spring Meeting House I do hereby Grant full privilege unto the present Church now Established, and in the Habit of attending at said Clear Spring Meeting house. Under the pastoral care of the Rev. Lewis Pector, or that may hereafter be Established for the orderly and laudible purpose of divine worship, as well as to those that are not within the walls of sd. Church who may think proper to attend at sd. Meeting House for the aforesaid orderly purpose, The bounds intended for this Public Purpose Having heretofore been ascertained by six corners & marked thus To wit Beginning on an ash corner at Mouth of sd. Clear Spring branch thence Running Southwardly on a line of marked Trees to a Chestnut corner thence Westwardly to a white oak Cr. on the branch of the land branch thence the meanders of said branch to the beginning Including the Clear Spring, also the aforesaid Meeting House, and supposed to contain a least three acres of land the full intent and meaning of this Instrument of writing is that the Persons aforesaid described are intitled, and shall for ever hereafter, be intitled to hold use and possess full privilege unto the aforesaid premises so far as is necessary for the aforesaid purpose & so long as they may think
