 State the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and  
 sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Robinson M.  
 Earle a certain tract of land containing two hundred acres be the same more  
 or less situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on the branches  
 of the Golden Grove Creek Waters of Saluda River originally granted to John  
 Maxwell Bigging at a stake corner running thence N. 42 E. 44.73 links to a Hickory  
 corner thence N. 48. W. 44.73 links to a post oak corner thence S. 42. W. 44.73 links to  
 a stake corner thence S. 48. E. 44.73 links to the beginning corner which will more fully appear  
 by having a Reference to the Original Grant and Plat - also an other Tract of  
 land situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid adjoining the said  
 tract beginning at a stake corner thence S. 54. E. 47 chains 50 links to a stake cor-  
 -ner on John Baines line thence S. 30. W. to a post oak corner thence N. 80. W. 55 chains  
 to a stake corner on Solyers line thence S. 18. W. 58 chains to a stake corner on Salu-  
 -da River thence up the said River to a cedar Hubbins corner on a  
 Stake thence N. 40. E. 48. chains 50 links to the beginning corner on John Maxwell  
 line containing one hundred and twenty six acres and three fourths being part  
 of a tract of land originally granted to Ambrose Blackburn and James Han-  
 -nison and conveyed by him to Crawford Goodwin to Have and to hold  
 the two before mentioned tracts of land with their appurtenances to the  
 said Robinson M. Earle his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby warrant  
 and for ever will defend the before mentioned land and premises to the said
