 same more or less bounded by lines running from the Ruddy fork on James
 Harrison line N. 24. E. 47 to the main Road, thence up said Road as it now
 runs, to Janey's line N. 37. W. 52 ch thence on Janey's line S. 2. E. 12.50 to a stake 3x
 thence on said line S. 80 W. 80 to a stake 3x thence S. 2. E. 12.50 to a post Oak 3x on
 Jesdale's line thence N. 80. E. 20 ch to the Ruddy Fork. thence down the same with
 the meanders to the beginning being part of four several Tracts & granted
 to John C. Kilpatrick, William Jesdale, Stephen Ford, and Owen Jenkins to have
