 Original line being a conditional line made between Moses Finckley and the
 said Isaac West thence S. East to a post oak corner on Thrustons line thence
 S. E to a post oak corner thence S. course to a black oak corner thence a
 westerly course to the beginning oak corner together with all and singular the Rights
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging
