Mr. Robbs all my part of a tract of land being one third part containing seventy six acres lying in Greenville district on banks of prochock Creek of South Tyger River granted to Capt. John Watson in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty six also my part being one third part being one third part and the part coming to Elizabeth Watson, Susannah Watson and William Watson legatus of Capt. John Watson dec'd of a tract of land containing one hundred and forty four acres the third part of that tract of land which belong to Thomas Moore granted to Joseph Whittier the seven the day of May one thousand seven hundred & eighty seven with my third part of twenty two acres of land that Capt. John Watson purchased of Walker lying on the south side of South Tyger River joining of Jesse Cannons land on their sides the above mentioned places together with John Watson Jr part of all the land belong to Capt. John Watson his father dec'd together with all and singular the Rights, revenues, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular premises before mentioned unto the sd. William Robbs his heirs & assigns for ever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and for ever defend all & singular the premises unto the sd.
