dollars have bargained, sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain  
sell & release unto Baylis Smith of the State aforesaid a certain Tract or parcel of land  
Containing one hundred & thirteen & a fourth acres be the same more or less, situate on  
Peters Creek waters of Enore River, begining at a R. O. 3<sup>x</sup> and runs S. 60 E to a Stake  
corner thence N. 30 E to a Stake 3<sup>x</sup> thence N. 60 W. to P. O. 3<sup>x</sup> thence S. 17 W. 20. 73 to a  
W. O. 3<sup>x</sup> thence S. 45 W. 4 to Chestnut 3<sup>x</sup> thence N. 60 W. 2. 95 to a P. O. 3<sup>x</sup> thence S. 30 W. to  
a R. O. 3<sup>x</sup> thence S. 42. W. 19. 38 to a R. O. 3<sup>x</sup> & so on to the beginning coming together  
with all and singular the rights numbers boundaries and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or pertaining to have  
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said Baylis Smith and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &  
Administrators to warrant & defend all and singular the premises be-  
fore mentioned unto the said Baylis Smith his heirs & assigns against myself  
my heirs & against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to cla-
