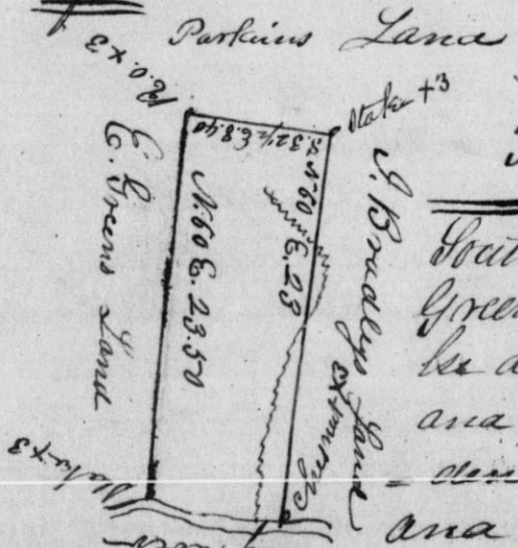

E 23.30 to a stake on the Bank of Kedy River thence up the River 8.40 links crossing the mouth of branch to a chestnut x 3 thence S. 60 W. to the beginning stake corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, burdiments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenant, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Crittenden his heirs and assigns forever; And I do hereby bind my self my heirs & executors and administrators to warrant and forever defende all and singular the said premises unto the said John Crittenden his heirs and assigns against my self, heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, witness my hand and seal this the twenty fourth day of June, one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one and a fifty fifth of the American independence. The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Jandy Walker of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of five thousand dollars to me in hand paid by John M. Lewis & John S. Rowland of Spartanburg Dist. in the State aforesaid have granted bargain, sold & released unto the said Lewis & Rowland a certain tract of land included in two grants a part of one originally granted to Henry Wolf & the other to W. D. Bradford. Beginning on a Sycamore on the bank of the River thence N. 15 E. 92.00 to a black gum or stake in the back line of W. D. Wolfs grant. thence N. 82. E. 21.50 on Wolfs back line to a stake thence N. 13 W. 45.00 to a chestnut thence N. 75. W. 31.50 to a hickory in Rowlands line thence with J. Rowlands line S. 39. W. 23.50 to a maple
