To all To Whome these Presents Shall Come I James McDaniel Sheriff of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid send Greeting Whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the district of Greenville tested the Twelfth day of April one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one at the Suit of John Hogg to me directions commanding me that of the Goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements of Benjamin & Charles Gordain to Levy the Sum of one hundred and Two dollars and thirty seven Cents with Interest and Costs I have seized and taken of the Lands and Tenements of the said Benjamin & Charles Gordain all that certain piece Parcel and tract of Land containing three Hundred and forty acres be the same more or less being in the district and state aforesaid on the north fork of Salludia River adjoining Land of Mr Morgain and others and Whereas the said Premises with their appertainances since the Seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at Public Vendue and Purchased by John Hodges of the District and State aforesaid for the sum of fifty five dollars being the Highest sum that was Bidden therefor now know ye that I the said James McDaniel Sheriff as aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and Delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such Cases made and provided and for an inconsideration of said Sum of fifty five dollars to me in hand paid or secured to to be paid by the said John Hodges the Receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted Bargained sold and by these presents do Grant Bargain and sell unto the said John Hodges his heirs and assigns forever the said piece tract piece and parcel of Land with its appertainances and
