 James West his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my-
 self my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and
 Singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said James West
 his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs and assigns and
 Every other person or persons Whomesoever Lawfully claimingly or to claim
 the Same or any part thereof in Witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and Seal this Eleventh day of June A.D. 1831

 conditional line to Armstrongs Creek thence up the meanders of
 said creek to a poplar on John Brackins line thence to a red oak
 corner on John Robertsons line thence a conditional line Between
