hundred and Twenty Seven acres being part of a certain tract of land containing  
Two hundred and fifty acres Granted to Hollisway Power by his Excellency Wm  
Moultry Esq & dated the sixth of November 1785 and Recorded in Secretaries  
office in Grant Book L L L Page 42 Bounded on Durbins creek Waters of  
Enoree River and conveyed from said Hollisway Power to the said John Austin  
the said Two hundred and Twenty seven acres Beginning on a Black gum 3x and
