The State of South Carolina, This Indenture made the Eleventh day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three Between William Choie Esqr Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the Said State of the one part and Jesse French of the other part Whereas George William James Elijah Washington Zorabella Ursulla Nancy Asa French and James Baker and Mary his Wife and Wiley Reeves and Ann his Wife on or about the Sixteenth day of April last did Exhibit their Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the Said State against Jonathan Jesse and Joel S. French and Larkin Davis and Elizabeth Davis his Wife praying among other things that the real Estate of John P French deceased may be divided and partitioned between his heirs and legal Representatives according to their Respective Rights and for that purpose that a writ of partition may issue directed to fit and proper persons to make partition of the Said real Estate Between the heirs at Law of the Said John P French Deceased and the Cause being at Issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at Last July Term when the Said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order a Judge and Decree that the Said Real Estate of the Said John P French deceased should be Sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the Said Court on the Terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order as by reference there to in the Registry of the Said Court will appear and the Said William Choie as Commissioner of the Said Court after having duly advertised the Said Land for Sale by Public outcry on the Said Eleventh day of November first above mentioned did then openly and Publicly and according to the Customs of Auctions Sell and dispose of the Said tract of Land below described unto the Said Jesse French for Seven hundred and fifty three dollars
