 by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and release unto the Said Jeremiah Cleveland  
 all that plantation or tract of land herein after described it being the tract  
 of land whereon Benjamin Bridges deceased lived on at his death which  
 said Bridges purchased of Joseph Bridges Thomas Edwards and others con-  
 -taining two hundred acres more or less it being all the land owned by  
 Benjamin Bridges adjoining said tract at his death which will more  
 fully appear by the different conveyances from Joseph Bridges to Benja-  
 -min Bridges Thomas Edwards and others to Benjamin Bridges together  
 with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurten-  
 -ances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or apper-  
 -taining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
 mentioned unto the Said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns  
 forever and we do here by bind ourselves heirs Executors and administrators to  
 to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
 said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns against ourselves our  
 heirs and against Every person Whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof Witness our hands and seals this the  
 second day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hun-  
 -dred and thirty three and in the fifty seventh year of the Independence  
 of the united States of America

 -tion of the Sum of two thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Jeremiah  
 Cleveland of the State and district aforesaid the Receipt Whereof is here by  
 Acknowledged have Granted Bargained Sold and released and conveyed  
 and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and release and convey  
 unto the Said Jeremiah Cleveland all that plantation tract or piece of land  
 Situate lying and being in the district of Greenville and State of South Caro-  
 -lina on Richland Creek Waters of Reedy River containing as appears by  
 a plat <sup>146</sup> made by John Watson Esquire Deputy Surveyor the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July  
 1827 four hundred and thirty two acres more or less out of which however is  
 excepted in this deed about twenty one acres which lies on the South Side
