February 22<sup>nd</sup> 1834 - We the undersigned do certify that agreeable  
Instructions of your order we convened at the Tyger Battalion Muster Ground  
and proceeded to lay of said Battalion in four Beat Companies in the  
manner and form following: Viz) Beat No one to Run from Chaney  
Stroads or Where the old Jugals Road Buncomb Road it being on the line  
dividing the Saludia and Tyger Battalion thence on the north End of  
said line untill it strikes the North Carolina line thence the East of said  
line to the Dividing Ridge between Tyger and Saludia Waters untill it  
strikes Gap Creek road leading from Hodge to Dickey thence down said  
road to said Dickey thence on the old Jugals Road to the beginning Batt-  
alion line Beat No 2 to Include Centes old Beat beginning at Lewis Dicks  
and Run up Gap Creek road leading to Col Hodge untill it strikes  
the Ridge dividing the Waters of Saludia and Tyger Rivers thence to Inter-  
sect the dividing line between North and S<sup>c</sup> Carolina till it strikes  
the Spartanburgh line to run on said line till it strikes the Jordan  
Road thence on the North End of said Road till it strikes the Gap Creek  
road thence up said Road to the beginning at said Dickey - Beat No  
3 to begin on Lewis Dickey on the old Jugals road leading to Chaney  
Stroads from Stroad along the Saludia Battalion line to Jenkins Mill  
thence along the main Road to the Double Spring meeting House thence  
along said Main Road to the Bridge thence down Tyger River to Spar-  
tanburgh line thence up Spartanburgh line to the Jordan Road thence  
up the Jordan Road to Gap Creek road thence up Gap Creek road to  
said Dickey - Beat No 4 to Commence at Thomas Bridge and  
Run thence on the main Road to Double Spring meeting House thence  
on said Road to Jenkins Mill thence along the Saludia Battalion
