E. 55 chains to a red oak 3x three N 50 W to a hickery thence N. 40. W to a Chest 3x N 50 E to the Beginning containing one hundred acres be the same more or less it being originally granted to Jacob Case also one other tract of land on the South Side of Fall Creek waters of Saludia River Beginning at said Creek Running S. 50.
