 of the district aforesaid and Absalom Barney of the district and State
 aforesaid Whereas a summons in partition to divide or sell certain
 tract of Land herein after described of the Estate of Absalom Barney
 deceased issued from the Court of ordinary of Said district and upon
 the return thereof the Judge of Said Court did Determine that the Said
 Land could not be divided without Injury to the ^{Interest of the} parties and did
 order the Same to be Sold by the Sheriff of the district aforesaid
 on credit of twelve months Whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did
 advertise Said land for Sale on the first Monday in January AD
 1833 and whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the day aforesaid
 Expose to Sale at Public outcry on the credit aforesaid the Said
 Land when Absalom Barney was the last and highest bidder to whom
 the Said Land was struck off for the sum of one hundred and sixty
 two dollars Now this Indenture Witnesseth that In Consideration of the
 sum of one hundred and sixty two dollars to me paid or secured to be
 paid I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and release to the Said Absalom Barney his heirs
 and assigns forever all that tract of Land Situate in Said district on both
 sides of Innee River containing by late survey by Thomas P Hudson one
 hundred and fifty six acres be the same more or less and hath such
 Bound marks as are described in a plat by Said Hudson hereunto an
 nexed it being part of a tract of Land originally granted to the Said
 Absalom Barney (Deceased) with the appertinances thereunto belonging
 and all the Estate right title Interest claim or demand which the Said
 Absalom Barney (Deceased) at the time of his death had in or to the same
 to have and to hold the Said tract of Land together with all & singular
 the premises Improvements and appertinances to the Said Absalom Barney
 and his heirs and assigns forever In Witness whereof I the Said John
 Watson as ordinary as aforesaid have hereunto set my hand and seal
 the day and year above mentioned
