 said Edward King at the death of the said Martha King and we
 moreover do quit claim to all of the said Estate of Edward King and
 Martha King of whatsoever kind or quality unto the said Tho
 P Brockman and forever Bar ourselves from said claim of Estate
 and place the said Brockman his heirs &c in our full Possession
 of right title and dower to the same at the death of Martha
 King and forever convey unto the same from ourselves our heirs
