 District aforesaid have bargained, granted, sold, and released and by
 these presents do bargain, grant, sell and release unto the said Abra-
 ham Mayfield his heirs and assigns all that or parcel of land in
 said District on Stony creek whereon the said Sanford now resides

Beginning on a stake on Stony Creek on Baldwins line thence
 west 45 Chain to a black oak 37 Thence S 40 E 30 to a rock 37
 on Bains line Thence S 30 E 10 to a Stake 37 Thence S 25 W 8 to a
 Spanish oak on Bains line Thence East to the Creek a white oak
 corner and up the creek to the beginning. Containing one hundred
 acres be the same more or less to have and to hold the premises as
 above described unto the said Abraham Mayfield his heirs and
 assigns forever with all and singular the rights hereditaments
 and appertinances belonging or appertaining thereto I the said
 Henry C. Sanford do hereby bind myself, heirs Executors &c
 to warrant and forever defend the same unto the said Abraham
 Mayfield his heirs, Executors &c against myself & mine and against
 all persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
