Whereas Semina Littleton late of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina deceased being previous to her death possessed of a considerable amount of property Real and personal divided the same equally among her children six in number and whereas the said Semina by deed of gift conveyed to her son Charles Littleton a certain tract of land lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the Suda River as will more fully appear by reference to said deed of Gift Now of Record in the district aforesaid - Now be it known that I Charles Littleton one of the children and heirs of sd Semina deceased have and do by this presents nominate constitute and appoint my friend John Gray of Muhlenberg County Kentucky my true and lawful attorney in fact for me and in my name to sell and convey the aforesaid land and premises upon the best terms and for the best price that can be had and make to the purchaser or purchasers a title thereto and I do further more authorize my said attorney to sign my name to any instrument of writing that may be necessary to complete the same and I do hereby authorize my said attorney to collect all sums of money or property which may be due me from said Estate or from any other source whatsoever and to collect all money that may owe me for rents or otherwise from the person or persons owing the same and to give such Receipt or Receipts therefor and to sign my name to any instrument of writing that may be necessary in the premises aforesaid that I might or could do were I personally present to do the same and to do and perform all such other acts and things in the premises aforesaid that may be legal and right hereby ratifying and confirming whatever my said attorney may legally do in the premises to be full and complete - In Testimony whereof I the said Charles Littleton have hereunto set my hand & seal this 11th day of October 1837
