

The 2nd day of March 1792 - Beginning at a white oak 3rd running thence N 50^o 30^o W to a Rock 3rd thence S 44^o 15^o W to a Red Oak sitting 3rd thence N 13^o to a stake 3rd thence S 82^o to the beginning - Together with all & singular the Rights Member Here defined & appointed to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Harrison his heirs & assigns forever and we do hereby bind myself my heirs & administrators & no further to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said John Harrison his heirs & assigns against myself & no further lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness our hands and seals the 1st day of February in the Year of our Lord in the Year Eighteen Hundred and Thirty One & in the fifty fifth Year of American Independence a.d. 1831.
