


I Vardry M^r Be of North Carolina for & in consideration of the sum of One hun-
dred dollar to me in hand paid by Philip C Lester of the District of Greenv-
ille in the state of South Carolina - Have this day bargained sold & conveyed
& doth by these presents sell & convey unto the said Philip C Lester part of a certain
Lot of Land known & distinguished by its N^o being 40 in the North East
square of the Village of Greenville Court House Beginning at a Stake on Coffe
& M^r Bee Streets & runs thence South 74 East two hundred feet to a stake corner
that divides this part of the Lot from that Decided for the use of the Methodist Church
thence South 16 West One hundred & Twenty feet along the line of the Church Land
to a Stake thence North 74 West to M^r Bee Street thence along the said Street to
the beginning being the corner of Coffe & M^r Bee Street & this part of the
said Lot N^o 40 being the balance or part of the Lot that the said Methodist Church
stands on - To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned with
the appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining unto
the said Philip C Lester his heirs & assigns and I the said Vardry M^r Be do
hereby bind myself, my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend the said premises
from me & my heirs & from the lawful claim of every other person or persons whom-
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same In Testimony whereof I the said
