State of South Carolina This indenture made the sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty, between David Henning of the first part and Vardry M<sup>r</sup> Bee of the second part both of the Village of Greenville and State and District aforesaid. Witnesseth (To Wit) Whereas the said David Henning did on the day of in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and for and in consideration of the sum of Five thousand dollars which the said David Henning was then justly indebted to the said Vardry M<sup>r</sup> Bee, the said David Henning did make and execute a deed of Conveyance to certain lots and Lands in & about the Village of Greenville and afterwards the said David Henning rented or leased the <sup>said</sup> premises from the said Vardry which shows the intention of the parties was to continue the possession of the premises in the said Vardry M<sup>r</sup> Bee and now in furtherance Confirmation and Consideration of the said sum of Five thousand dollars the payment of which is now and was before fully acknowledged to be paid and to confirm the same title, I the said David Henning do hereby convey the same lands and premises and for in consideration of the further sum of Five dollars to me in hand paid by the said,
