does freely voluntarily and without any compulsion dread or fear  
of any person or persons whomsoever renounce release and forever  
relinquish unto the said Anthony M. Jones his heirs and assigns  
all her right title interest and estate and also all her right  
and claim of dower of in or to all and singular the premises  
within mentioned and released Given under my hand Seal  
this 24 January 1840

Fuller and Andrew Fuller of the County of Hickman State of  
Kentucky have made nominated and appointed and by  
these presents do make nominate and appoint Thomas H  
Pease of the City of Charleston South Carolina our true and  
lawful attorney for us and in our name To convey unto Sam-  
uel Gibson and William J. Gibson of Greenville District State  
of South Carolina all the right title and interest we have  
in and to a certain tract of land lying and being in  
Greenville District State of South Carolina according to the  
full intent and stipulations of a note of hand given to the said  
Charles H Fuller by the aforesaid Samuel Gibson and William  
J. Gibson bearing date the 22<sup>d</sup> day March 1833. And the said  
Thomas H Pease as our attorney for us and in our name and for  
our use and benefit to ask demand sue for recover and receive of  
and from Samuel Gibson and William J. Gibson of Greenville  
District State of South Carolina all such sum or sums of money  
debts and demands whatsoever which are now due and owing  
unto us the said Charles H Fuller and Andrew Fuller by
