 do by these presents grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 Nathaniel Morgan his heirs and assigns all that tract of land
 whereon the said Benjamin Barbara lived and where his widow
 now lies containing by a late survey one hundred and fifty seven
 acres and $\frac{1}{2}$ be the same more or less situated lying and being in
 the same State and district aforesaid on branches of Enoree River
 Beginning on a Maple 3 x N 50 E 4 chains to a pine 3 x thence S 40 E
 10.40 to a Black Oak 3 x thence N 77 E 8.50 to a Maple on Cam Snake
 Branch thence up the meanders of said branch to Judly Howell's
 Maple corner on S. branch thence N 3 E 37.75 to Sour Wood 3 x N 14
 E 4 to a stake near the head of a branch thence N 6 W 9.40 to a B.C.
 3 x thence S 89 E 24 to a white Oak 3 x thence S 30 W 3.50 to a Dogwood
 3 x thence S 30 W 23 to a stake 3 x thence S 30 W 10. to White Oak
 3 x dead thence down the branch to the Beginning which
