

H. Dickey the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Lewis H. Dickey his heirs and assigns for ever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said Samuel M. Watson of right had in or to the same. To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Lewis H. Dickey his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said David Henning Sheriff might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writs of fieri facias or otherwise.
