Jefferson Barton and the said John Watson, and we the aforesaid Walton Stator, Daniel Pace and Squire Morgan, do hereby bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, Exors, & Adm^{rs} to stand to and abide by the decisions and award of the above named referees, witness our hands and seals the day & year above written signed, sealed, and delivered in presence of John Philips

Mr James Pickett, Jefferson Barton & John Watson having been chosen by Walton Stator Squire Morgan and Daniel Pace to settle some conflicting claims to lands situate in said district on Fall Creek of the North fork of Saluda River do hereby award ~~all~~ to the said Walton Stator all that portion of his claim in the grant made to John Gaudle on both sides of the said creek except fourteen acres viz. Beginning at a Chestnut 9x of said Gaudle's survey on the north side of said creek thence N 68 E 29 chs to a Stake thence S 70 E 10 chs to a Stone 3x thence S 88 W 28.50 chs to the beginning which fourteen acres we award to the said Morgan. The said Daniel Pace is to have sufficient time to gather the present crop and remove it off his claim, at which time all his claim under the grant made to Mr Ruppel contained within the boundary of the Grant is the said Gaudle to cease, and no further claim to be set up by him or his heirs or assigns to said land. The aforesaid fourteen acres to be all the land the said Morgan his heirs or assigns is to claim of the grant made to Mr Ruppel. Given under our hands and seals this 8th Oct 1840
