South Carolina Know all men by these presents that we Greenville District Nathaniel Morgan and Samuel Morgan for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and seventy two dollars fifty two cents to us in hand paid by Aldridge Green of said State and district have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents grant bargain sell and release unto the said Aldridge Green his heirs and assigns all that tract of land whereon Sarah Barbara lived where Nancy Brown now lies containing by late survey One hundred and fifty seven Acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the State and district aforesaid on Branches of Enoree River Beginning on a Maple 3<sup>+</sup> N. 50. E. 4 chains to a Pine 3<sup>+</sup> Thence S 40 E 10-40 to a Black Oak 3<sup>+</sup> thence N 79 E 8.50 to a Maple on cane brake branch thence up the meander of said Branch to Dudley Woods Maple Corner on said Branch thence N 3 E. 37. 75 to a Tower Wood 3<sup>+</sup> N 14 E 4 to a stake near the Head of a branch - Thence N 6 W. 9. 40 to a R. Oak 3<sup>+</sup> thence S 89. E. 24 to a White Oak 3<sup>+</sup> thence S 30 W. 3. 50 to a dog Wood 3<sup>+</sup> thence S 3 W 23 to a stake 3<sup>+</sup> thence S 36 W. 10 to a White Oak 3<sup>+</sup> dead thence down the Branch to the Beginning which contains the lands to be conveyed.
