 one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James Cox the
 receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bar-
 gained sold & released & and these presents do bargain sell
 & release unto the said James Cox a certain piece of Land
 thence Isaac Hicks now lives containing fifty acres more or
 less lying & being in Greenville District & State aforesaid on the
 head waters of Rudy Fork Creek bounded by adjoining lands
 of Samuel Hicks & Isaac Cox & Wm Cox & Cox commencing on a
 stake at the mouth of a drain against Isaac Coxes & thence along said
 Isaac Coxes line onto the corner on a black oak thence long
 A Coxes line to a post oak corner thence on said Coxes line
 to a white oak corner on the said drain thence down the drain
 aforesaid on a conditional line to the beginning & stake corner
 the same being part of a tract originally granted to Alexander
 Haddle with all and singular the members hereditaments appurten-
 -ances every part & parcel thereof the rights & title whereof I
 do give & sell my heirs Executors & administrators unto the said James
