Granville District } become indebted to John C. Sullivan
the sum of One hundred & forty dollars eighty four $\frac{1}{2}$ Cents
for which he holds my Note given the 5th Decr 1840. also
the said Sullivan holds my security to 2 Notes One for
One hundred dollars given February 1838 to William Anderson
and the other to James Thompson for Three hundred
Dollars dated some time last winter. Now know all
men by these presents that I William Meeks in order
to secure said debts due the said Sullivan of One hundred
and forty dollars eighty four $\frac{1}{2}$ Cents and also in the
event he has to pay the Note of Three hundred Dollars
to James Thompson and the Note of One hundred Dollars
to William Anderson as well as one dollar in hand
paid me by John C. Sullivan I have mortgaged the
tract of lands of One hundred and Seventy six acres
whereon I now live to the said John C. Sullivan lying
on the North side of Reedy River adjoining lands of
Asberry Terry, Gaston Terry & Lawson J. Arnold the said
land to remain bound to the said Sullivan for
the above promissory Notes. The condition of the
above mortgage is that if I the said William
Meeks shall pay off the Note of Three hundred
Dollars and interest to James Thompson
or the person holding said Note & the Note of
