of Coffee Street, and adjoining land of W<sup>m</sup> Turpin  
and others - Together with all and singular the rights  
Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the  
said Premises belonging or in anywise incident  
or appertaining, To Have and to Hold, all and singular  
the Premises before mentioned, unto the said Peter  
Cault his Heirs and assigns forever. And I  
do hereby bind myself & my Heirs, Executors and  
Administrators to warrant and forever defend,  
all and singular the said Premises, unto the  
said Peter Cault his Heirs and assigns, against  
me and my Heirs, and against every person whom-  
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
or any part thereof.
