Have granted bargained sold released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said McNulty all that tract piece or parcel of land lying on Saluda River in the District aforesaid beginning at a Beach Corner at Dunham's Bridge, running thence parallel with the main Road to Greenville O'House N 81. E 17. 34 to a cherry tree. thence N 48. E 67 to a Stake corner. thence S 19. E 8 to a Stake corner on the ditch. thence up the ditch to a Stake corner at the mouth of the gully. thence S 22. E 3 to a Stake corner on the gully. thence S 58. W 7 to a small cherry tree corner near to a fallen down white Oak thence S 11. E 14 to a forked Poplar on the River thence up the river to the Beginning Beach corner containing fifty one acres. be the same more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident. To have & to hold the same to himself.
