N 30 W 6.90 to Spanish Oak 3x, thence N 86 W 15.00 to a

by Jesse Bagwell. thence N 83 W 13.60 to a P. Oak 3x  
bounded by S. H. Shumate. thence S 7 W 19.40 to a
