

Joseph Barton and in consideration of a like conveyance to me this day executed by the said Joseph Barton for part of the above described tract have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Barton all my right title interest claim and demand whatsoever in or to all and singular to that part of the tract of land above mentioned which lays South of said tract, beginning on a stake on the East side of the Buncombe road (running thence S. fifty links to a stake in the middle of the road thence along the middle of said road S. twenty four East. five chains to a stake in the road, thence S. 20° Eighty East twenty three chains ninety links to a conditional Book Corner at N.E. corners fence to be the line between us supposed to contain sixty one acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and to hold all and singular, the said part of the tract above mentioned unto the said Joseph Barton his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said Joseph Barton his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this fourth day of May one thousand eight hundred and forty one

South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I William Greenville District McCullough of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of Twelve hundred dollars to me paid by Nimrod Donaldson of said State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Nimrod Donaldson a tract of land in the State and District aforesaid lying on the South side of Horse Creek beginning on a Chingupin on the Creek thence to a Black Oak being a corner of land said McCullough bought of Charles P. Hutton thence N 50° W. 23.6 to a maple 3x. on the South bank of said Creek thence up the mill pond to a maple in the head of said pond thence S 21° E. 27 to a Dead Oak 3x. thence S 5° W. 6. to a Dogwood thence S 56° E. 8 to a Stake thence S 5° W. 22.17 to a Stake 3x. thence S 85° E. 20 to a Hickory 3x. thence S 2° W. to said Donaldson's line thence along said line about 18 chains
