Evans of the District and State aforesaid. For and in consideration of the love  
and good will which I have and do bear towards my wife Grace Evans of the  
District and State aforesaid have given and granted and by these presents  
do freely give and grant unto the said Grace Evans the following  
negroes viz, Phillis and her now Youngest Child called Emaline, Allen,  
Harriet, and Hannah also two Feather Beds and Bed Clothing. This Property I  
give to her that she may have and hold it as her property hereafter without  
any manner of Condition In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and Seal this 10th Day of December Eighteen Hundred and forty
